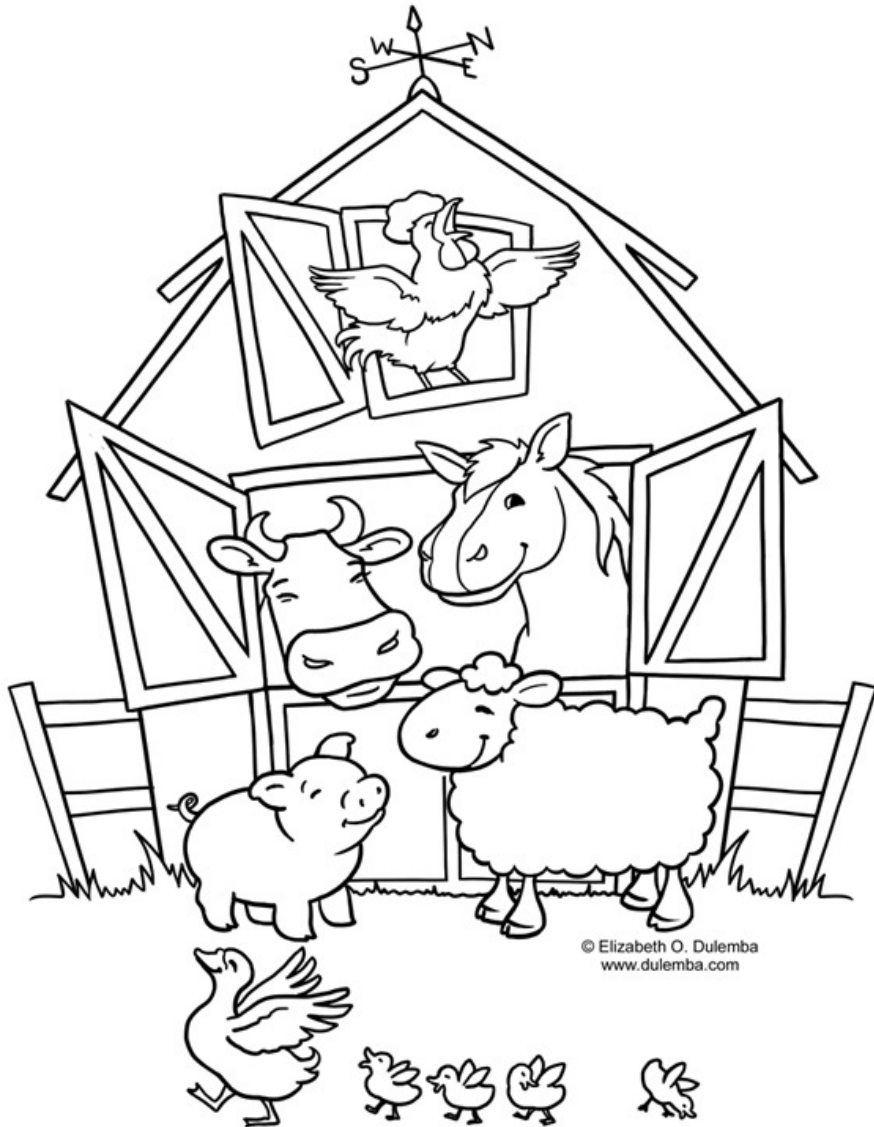

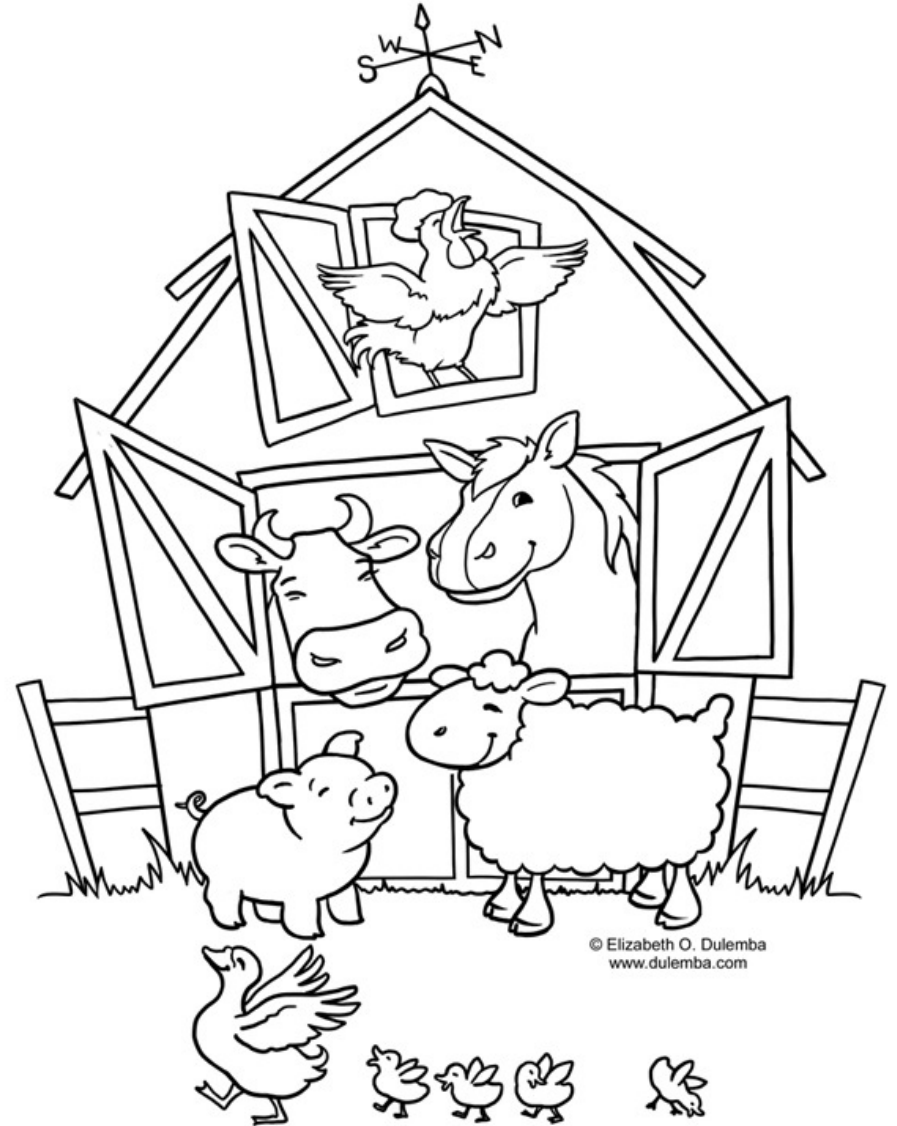

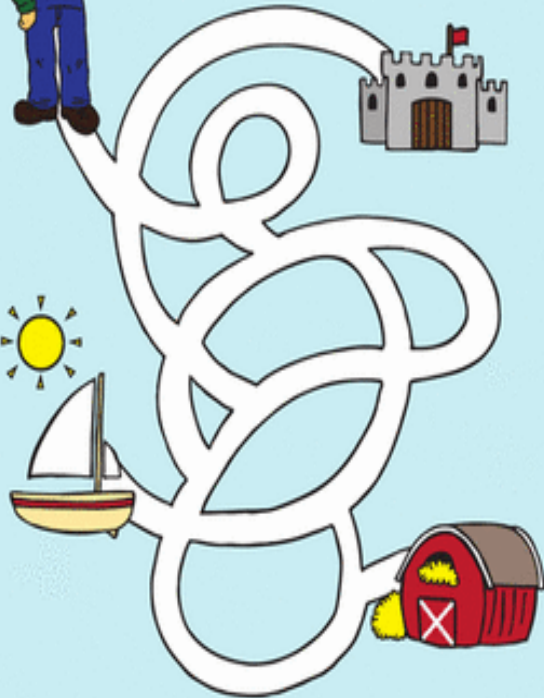

Can you help me find my barn?



Sweet Edible Haystacks

You'll need:

- 1 bag chocolate chips
- 1 bag butterscotch chips
- 1 can of Chinese noodles

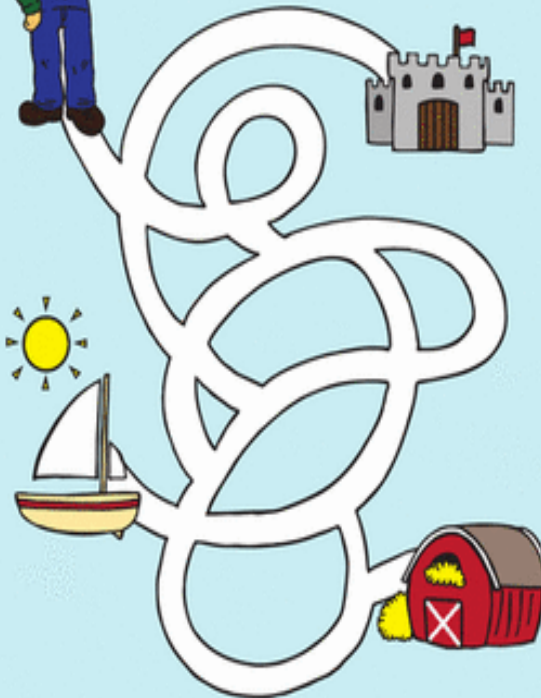
Melt the chocolate and butterscotch chips together in a microwave safe bowl, stirring every 30 seconds. When completely melted, stir in the Chinese noodles. Drop by table-spoonful onto waxed paper and allow to cool. Pretend you're a barn animal, eating your hay!
