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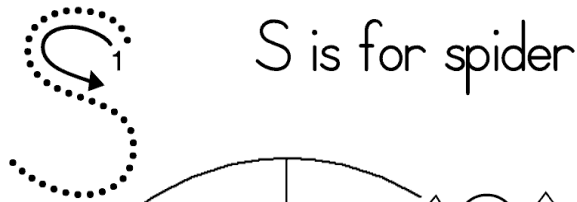
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S is for spider

### Paper Plate Spider Webs

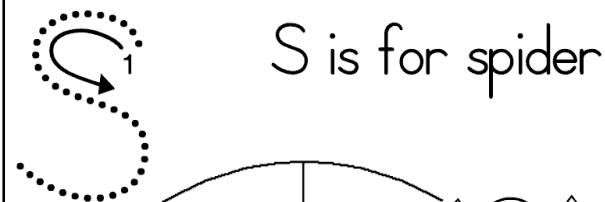
*Materials:* Heavy duty paper plate, scissors, yarn, plastic spider

Cut 8 triangles in the edge of the plate. Allow your child to weave yarn around the plate. Try different patterns or colors of yarn. Add the spider.

Educator I parent: Read these instructions to child. Trace letter S with your finger. Connect the dots with black pencil or crayon. Help the spider reach her web. Count the legs on the spider.

**Know when to stop and when to read it again and again.** Put the book away if your child loses interest or is having trouble paying attention...even in the middle! Go ahead and read your child's favorite book over and over.



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
