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S is for spider Red these instructions to child. Trace letter 5 with your finger. Connect the dots with black need or crown. Help the spider each her web. Count the lens on the spider.


Paper Plate Spider Webs

Materials: Heavy duty paper plate, scissors, yarn, plastic spider

Cut 8 triangles in the edge of the plate. Allow your child to weave yarn around the plate. Try different patterns or colors of yarn. Add the spider.
