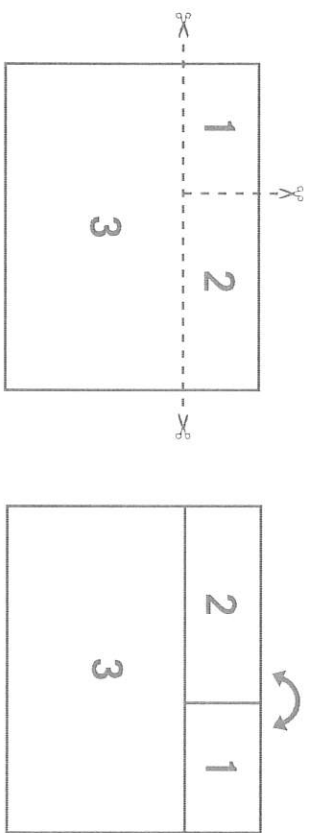

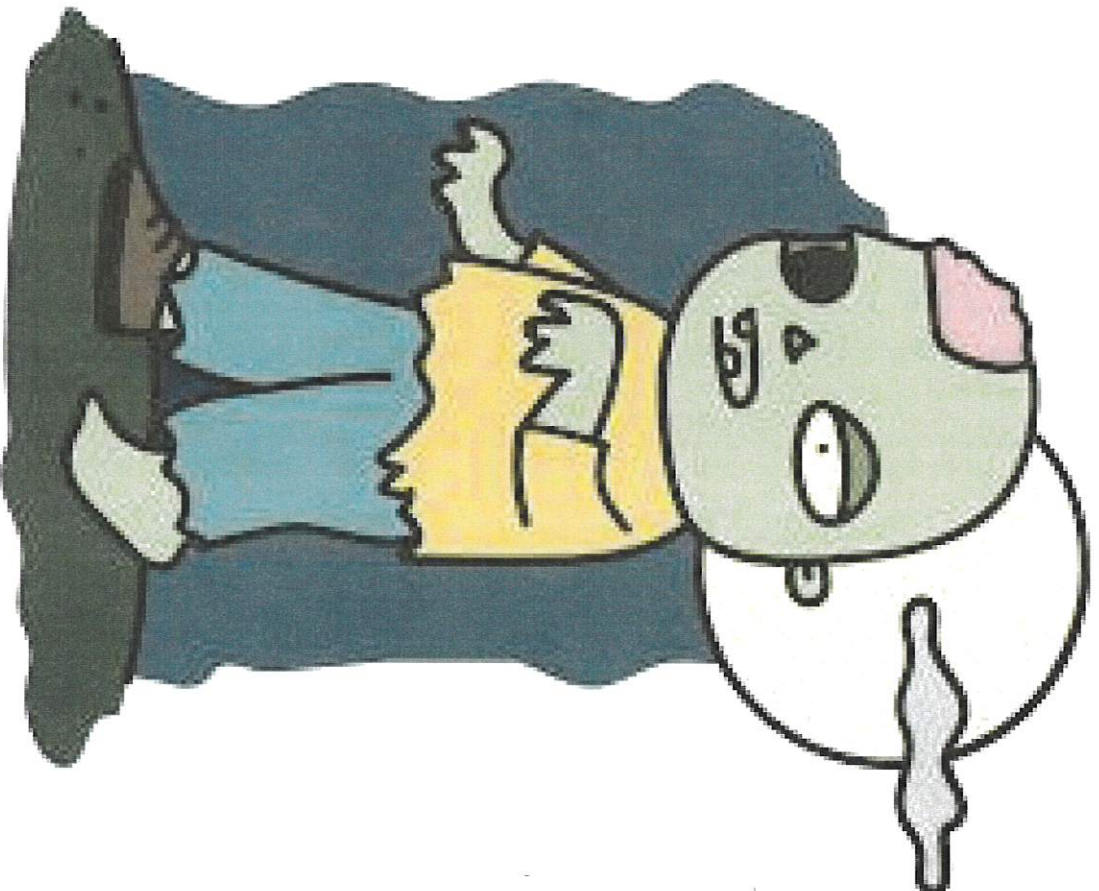
Instructions:

3. Switch parts 1 and 2, and replace over part 3.

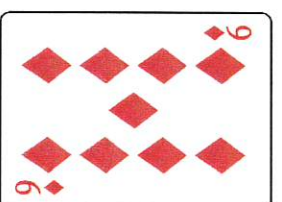
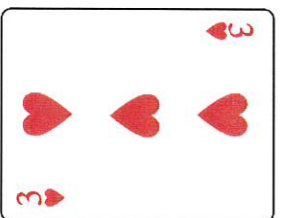
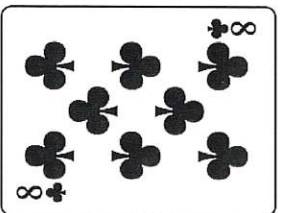
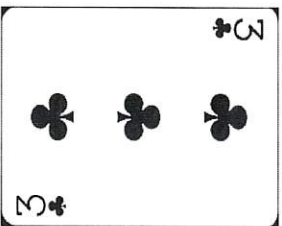
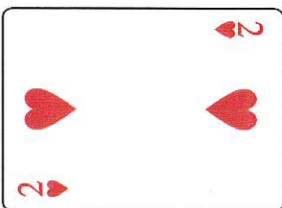
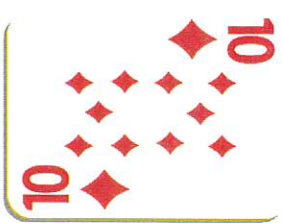
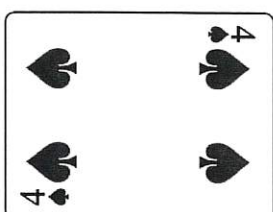
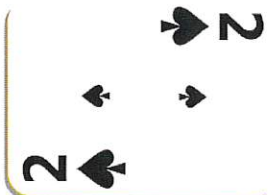
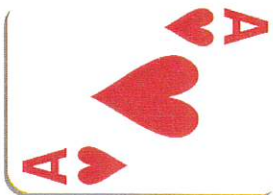
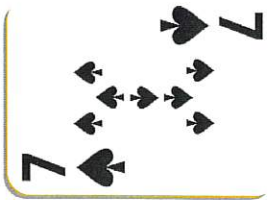

Trick Preparation:

Take the following cards out of a deck of cards: 3-10, Ace, King, Queen, Jack. It does not matter if they are the same suit.

Put these cards in the following order:

- Place the 3 face-up on the table.
- On top of the 3, place the 8, 7, Ace, Queen, 6, 4, 2, Jack, King, 10, 9, 5

3 8 7 A Q 6 4 2 J K 10 9 5

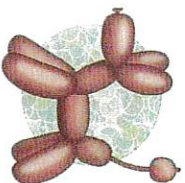
